Tom Johnson is former chairman and chief executive officer of CNN News Group. He was publisher and chief executive officer of the *Los Angeles Times* and deputy press secretary to President Lyndon B. Johnson.

Karen Jurgensen is editor of *USA TODAY*. She began there as topics editor in the Life department. She also worked as assistant city editor of *The Miami News*.

Monica Lozano is president and chief operating officer of the Spanish-language newspaper *La Opinion* in Los Angeles. She is vice president of Lozano Communications and was publisher of *El Eco del Valle*.

Tim McGuire is editor and senior vice president of the *Star Tribune* in Minneapolis. Earlier he was managing editor. He previously worked as managing editor of the *Ypsilanti* (Mich.) *Press*.
